There are so many great things happening in April. To start the month off, we honor the celebration of Easter (April 9). We are also in a new phase of Art II review:

At General Assembly 2023, Unitarian Universalists will take an initial vote on proposed changes to Article II. Your UUA Board of Trustees hopes to maximize discussion and engagement with these proposed changes, which address the foundational values and purposes of our faith.

Until April 30, 2023, any Unitarian Universalist may submit suggestions and ideas, through an online form, for ways they recommend modifying the Article II Study Commission proposal.
